

Earth's Changing Land GCTE-LUCC Open Science Conference was held in Barcelona, Spain from March 14-18, 1998.

The Global Change and Terrestrial Ecosystems (GCTE) and Land-Use/Cover Change (LUCC) Core Projects held an open Science Conference in 1998. GCTE studies the effects of changes in climate, atmospheric composition, and land use on terrestrial ecosystems, and the consequent feedback to climate and atmosphere. LUCC aims to document and understand global land-use and land-cover change, the forces that drive it, its relationship to climate and biogeochemistry, and the links between sustainability and land use.
